### **Use of Colored and Flashing Lights on Vehicles**

State law restricts the color of lights that may be displayed on vehicles and generally prohibits the use of flashing lights on motor vehicles and equipment, except under certain circumstances (eg, signaling a turn or to indicate a disabled vehicle) (CGS § 14-96p)
