If you are not sure of the difference, it might be helpful to use your prior knowledge and think of what you do know of topic and main idea Since most of us like movies, it could be helpful to think of topic and main idea in terms of a film

### **Determining the Central Idea of a Text**

Definition: The central idea (main idea) in a piece of writing is the point that the author wants you to remember most Some writers may state the main idea, but it is often implied, which means the reader has to make inferences (what the text says + what I know) about it Just like theme in fiction, the central idea is not a topic or

### **Finding the Main Idea - Monterey Peninsula College**

Finding the main idea is a key to understanding what you read The main idea ties all of the sentences in the paragraph or article together Once you identify the main idea, everything else in the reading should click into place The rest of the reading is the evidence provided to support that main idea Finding the Main Idea Find the topic first
